FIRE COMPANY

Septic System Maintenance Plan-DEP has sent a letter denying the request for a 4 year pump out cycle and the implementation schedule of the pump out ordinance of 2021. They need a written response by October 25, 2019. A motion was made to have a letter that was drafted by Supervisor Gutheil to DEP requesting where in the law it states there must be a 3 year pump out ordinance and explain the reasoning for the 4 year request and for the implementation schedule; Gutheil/Smithgall. Motion carried.
