

Watts Township

June 2, 2021

The Watts Township Board of Supervisors regular business meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 2, 2021 at the Watts-Buffalo Community Center by Chairman Karl Raudensky with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Secretary announced that the meeting was being recorded to aid in the preparation of the minutes.

A motion was made to approve the May 5, 2021 minutes as read; Smithgall/Miller. Motion carried.

SECRETARY

Nancy announced all visitors to the office must wear face masks. There is 1 Right to Know request. A motion was made to transfer the General Fund CD that is maturing on June 21, 2021 to a Municipal Easy Access CD at Pennian Bank; Raudensky/Smithgall. Motion carried.

SOLICITOR

Solicitor Fenicle has advertised the Nuisance Ordinance to be considered for adoption at the July 7th meeting.

ZONING OFFICER

Judy Hart has submitted a letter of resignation from the Zoning Officer and Code Enforcement Officer position effective immediately. A motion was made to accept the resignation; Raudensky/Smithgall. Motion carried. Jerry Spease as the alternate will take over the position. Permits issued for the month of May: Harvey-new home, Ranch House-covered deck, Anderson-raise roof over garage, Gibney-pool, Gardner-new home.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- Adoption of the On-lot Sewage Management Program Ordinance has been postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic-Supervisor Miller provided Tim Wagner with an update as requested. Mr. Wagner was satisfied with the response but it will have to be adopted and implemented.
- 102 Skyview Lane- The 30 day time limit is approaching for the owner to have the property cleaned up. Supervisor Miller will speak to Judy Hart to see if she is willing to finish that process or if Jerry needs to.

NEW BUSINESS

Nancy reported the American Recue Plan funds that the township is to apply for is \$134,418.62. She has to complete and submit DCED's single application and obtain a SAM (System for Award Management) number from the Federal Government first. It needs to be submitted within 5 days. There are restrictions on how the funds can be spent. 50% of the funds will be received in July 2021 and the other 50% in July 2022. The township has until December 2024 to spend the funds.

Supervisor Miller said he was approached regarding the township paying the Community Center a monthly rental fee versus donations for use of their facility for meetings. The issue was tabled until the next meeting.

ROAD MASTER

Jay Fulkroad and Sons, Inc was the only bid received for the paving work on Morris Rd. Item A, 638 tons of 9.5mm leveling course at \$89.87 per ton for a total of \$57,337.06 and Item 1A, 638 tons of 9.5

wearing course at \$85.45 per ton for a total of \$81,861.10. Total bid is \$139,198.16. A motion was made to table a decision until the next meeting; Smithgall/Raudensky. Motion carried.

Bob Whitmore announced the Community Center will be holding a bingo night on June 19th.

A motion was made to pay the bills and any bills that come due before the next meeting; Raudensky/Smithgall. Motion carried.
