Present: Vice Chair Dr. Patricia Gutheil, Supervisor Glenn Smithgall, Secretary/Treasurer Nancy Cangioli and 3 residents. Chairman Raudensky was absent.

The Watts Township Board of Supervisors special business meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 17, 2019 at the Watts Township Municipal Building by Vice Chair Dr. Patricia Gutheil with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made to resubmit the Act 537 plan with a proposed 4 year On Lot Sewage Management Program Ordinance and addressing the technical deficiencies letter from DEP dated June 6, 2019; Gutheil/Smithgall. Motion carried. DEP must receive it by July 30th.

Ralph Rudy stated that there is a petition already signed by 200 people who are against the pump out requirements of any kind.

A motion was made to send Arthur Bruaw's zoning map change request application to the Perry County Planning Commission and the Watts Township Planning Commission for review; Smithgall/Gutheil. Motion carried.

Supervisor Smithgall reported nothing is being done to clean up 102 Skyview Lane. The Board approved allowing Ralph Rudy to talk with Angie the owner to get the house boarded up at least. Ralph thanked the Board for allowing him to help out with the situation.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 10:35 a.m.; Smithgall/Gutheil. Motion carried.
