### **ENGINEER**

Jerry has completed the DEP application for the General Permit for Morris Rd and it will be mailed Thursday. There is no update on the Keller Auto Body Land Development plan. He performed a speed study on Knuth Rd, Scotch Circle and Island Rd. He also corrected the township road numbers that were not correct in the Speed Limit ordinance.

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Engineer Spease's speed study determined that the speed limits for Knuth Rd be 25 mph, Island Rd -30 mph, and Scotch Circle 25 mph. A motion was made to draft a new Speed Limit ordinance per Jerry's recommendations; Miller/Smithgall. Motion carried. Nancy will check with the Solicitor on advertising requirements.

Engineer Spease completed a traffic study on Knuth Rd. A motion was made to authorize the Solicitor to draft a No Parking Ordinance and to hold a special meeting on August 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. at the Community Center and invite the residents on Knuth Rd to try and resolve the parking issues only; Miller/Raudensky. Motion carried.

A motion was made to donate \$1,000 to the Watts Buffalo Community Center; Smithgall/Raudensky. Motion carried.

Karl reported patching is being done and taking care of the berms.

**PLANNING COMMISSION**

There was a meeting on June 10<sup>th</sup> and the draft minutes have been received. 1 subdivision plan was received on July 29<sup>th</sup> for M&J acquisitions, Timothy Maus, Linda McElheny, Richard Romberger and 1 subdivision plan for Robert and Gertrude Schreiber for the August meeting.
